DECLARATION OF JACKSON MUKASA

- I, Jackson Mukasa, hereby declare as follows:
 - 1. I am a citizen and resident of Uganda.
- 2. On 27 January 2014, I was at the home of Kim Mukisa when local council authorities and neighbors arrived demanding that Kim be evicted for being a homosexual and they began to beat him. They also accused me of being homosexual and also started beating me.
- 3. After Kim was beaten and went to report the case to the legal aid clinic at Human Rights Awareness and Promotion Forum, I was arrested by the police and brought to the police station.
- 4. At the police station, the police officers beat, and forced me to call Kim, and when Kim arrived at the station, the police arrested him too.
- 5. Kim and I were held for approximately seven days before we were brought before a judge.
- 6. I was charged with permitting a person to have carnal knowledge of me against the order of nature.

- 7. While I was in detention, the police invited the media to the police station and they brought me out before them and allowed the media to take my photographs.
- 8. The police officers subjected me to an HIV test without my consent and to a degrading anal exam.
- 9. Kim and I were held in custody until 12 May and 7 May 2014 when we were released on bail respectively.
 - 10. The case against us was dismissed on 22 October 2014.
 - 11. The entire experience was extremely stressful and degrading.

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, I declare under the penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States of America that the foregoing is true and correct.
