DECLARATION OF KIM MUKISA

- I, Kim Mukisa, hereby declare as follows:
 - 1. I am a citizen and resident of Uganda.
- 2. On 27 January 2014, I was forcibly evicted from my home after the local council and some area residents came to my home demanding to throw me out for being a homosexual. They also accused Jackson Mukasa, a transgender woman, who was in my home at the time, of being homosexual. They beat me and I had to seek medical attention and also to report the case to the legal aid clinic at Human Rights Awareness and Promotion Forum.
- 3. I was later called by Jackson, to go to the police station where she had been arrested. When I arrived, I was arrested too.
- 4. I was held for approximately seven days before Jackson and I were brought before a judge.
- 5. I was charged with having carnal knowledge of a person against the order of nature.
 - 6. While I was in detention, the police invited the media to the police station and

they brought me out before them and allowed the media to take my photographs.

- 7. The police subjected me to an HIV test without my consent.
- 8. Jackson and I were held in custody until we were released on bail on 7 and 12 May 2014 respectively.
 - 9. The case against us was dismissed on 22 October 2014.
- 10. My arrest and the criminal proceedings were humiliating, degrading and very stressful. The media coverage of my case was also very humiliating and stressful.

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, I declare under the penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States of America that the foregoing is true and correct.
