ORDER

In this action brought under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the plaintiff appeals summary judgment for the defendant. After a briefing schedule had been initiated, a motion to intervene was filed by the former employee on whose behalf the action was initiated. The defendant opposes the motion to intervene.

Pending the court’s ruling on the motion to intervene, all briefing in this appeal, including the brief of the proposed intervenor and any briefs by amicus in support of the plaintiff appellant, will be held in abeyance. Upon the court’s issuance of a ruling on the motion to intervene, the briefing will resume on a schedule as established at that time.
