I represent appellant Matthew Christiansen.

Today a Gregory Antollino filed on this docket a "Notice of Appearance for Substitute, Additional, or Amicus Counsel" to appear for parties named Zarda (Dkt. 132). I respectfully request that the court remove that filing from the docket as it violates Local Rule 12.3(b) and it muddies the record. Moreover, this case is closed and he has no right or standing to interfere with the procedure of it.

Local Rule 12.3(b) requires filing that notice only when an attorney "appears in a case in any capacity on behalf of a party or an amicus curiae...". Mr. Antollino is not an attorney for any party nor an amicus curiae. Whoever his clients are named Zarda, they do not belong here and apparently have their own separate and completely different case awaiting a decision from this court. Mr. Antollino should not file here to leverage a potential decision there. Moreover, his filings give the false impression that he is related to this case when he is not and he has no standing to file here. No less, he should not ignore this Court's rules.

Mr. Antollino's spat of filings on this docket since yesterday are improper and confuse the docket. Naturally by this letter I am noticing him to cease interfering with this case which is wasting counsels' and judicial resources, and I respectfully ask for such a notice to him from the court as well.
