Dear Judge Failla:

This office represents the plaintiff in the above-captioned matter. I respectfully request that the stay be lifted or holding a pre-motion conference on lifting the stay.

This court stayed this case pending the outcome of *Zarda* in the Second Circuit. Unlike *Zarda* that lost all claims, the Second Circuit granted Mr. Christiansen his cause of action for sexual stereotyping. The only effect to this case is that if *Zarda* prevails then Plaintiff's sexual orientation cause of action is revived. However, sexual stereotyping and sexual orientation claims subsume each other when it comes to discovery and evidence. The same discovery would be sought regarding those causes of action and Title VII discrimination.

This case is over two years old. Parties and witnesses are relocating and will be hard to find. Also, the case should move forward so R. 26 discovery can be exchanged. Notably, plaintiff has a right to review defendants' insurance coverage and related initial discovery. At least the court should order that exchange now. Finally, plaintiff wants to amend his complaint regarding damages related to his physical injuries. That amendment should be allowed as matter of course. All of that can be achieved without awaiting *Zarda*

It would benefit the case to get R. 26 discovery and a preliminary conference order to schedule discovery and other matters.

I respectfully request that the Court lift the stay, or, alternatively permit a pre-motion conference or permit motions filed on the issue of lifting the stay.
