Upon consideration of the Parties' proposed schedule (ECF No. 141), the following deadlines are hereby set by the Court:

- July 25, 2017: Settlement Conference with Magistrate Judge Goodwin
- August 14, 2017: Deadline for Plaintiff to file opposition to Defendants' Second Motion in Limine (ECF No. 98)
- August 14, 2017: Deadline for Plaintiff to file motion to compel regarding Defendants' claims of privilege over ESI. *See* ECF No. 66 at 2 and ECF No. 113.
- August 24, 2017: Deadline for Defendants to file final witness list
- August 24, 2017: Deadline for Defendants to file objections to Plaintiff's and Plaintiff-Intervenor's exhibit lists

- September 23, 2017: Deadline to complete discovery
- September 23, 2017: Deadline to file dispositive and *Daubert* motions
- September 23, 2017: Deadline for Plaintiff and Plaintiff-Intervenor to file objections to Defendants' exhibit list
- October 17, 2017: Final pretrial report to be filed together with a proposed order approving the report
- October 25, 2017: Deadline for parties to file designations of deposition portions to be used at trial
- October 31, 2017: Objections and counter-designations to designations of deposition testimony to be used at trial must be filed
- November trial calendar setting

Motions in limine, requested voir dire, trial briefs, and requested jury instructions to be filed seven (7) days prior to the pretrial report. Any objections or responses to motions in limine, requested voir dire, trial briefs, and requested jury instructions to be filed within 14 days after the initial filing to which the party is responding or to which the party objects.
