26 WHEREAS, Plaintiffs have filed a motion seeking a preliminary injunction
27 [Docket No. 15] (the "Preliminary Injunction Motion") in this action;

1 WHEREAS, Defendants have advised Plaintiffs that they intend to bring a
2 motion to dismiss (the “Motion to Dismiss”);

3 WHEREAS, the Parties agree that good cause exists to brief the Preliminary
4 Injunction Motion and Motion to Dismiss together because Defendants have
5 represented that issues that they intend to raise in their Motion to Dismiss overlap
6 with the issues raised in the Preliminary Injunction Motion;

7 WHEREAS, the Parties have met and conferred, and agree that the
8 following schedule will allow them sufficient time to brief the Preliminary
9 Injunction Motion and Motion to Dismiss:

- 10 • Defendants will file their combined Motion to Dismiss and Opposition to
11 Plaintiffs’ Preliminary Injunction Motion no later than October 23, 2017;
- 12 • Plaintiffs will file their Reply in support of their Preliminary Injunction
13 Motion and Opposition to Defendants’ Motion to Dismiss no later than
14 November 6, 2017; and
- 15 • Defendants will file their Reply in support of their Motion to Dismiss no
16 later than November 13, 2017;

17 WHEREAS, the Parties have met and conferred, and jointly request that the
18 Preliminary Injunction Motion and the Motion to Dismiss be set for hearing on
19 November 20, 2017 at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the Court’s schedule
20 permits.

21 THEREFORE, THE PARTIES STIPULATE, AGREE, AND JOINTLY
22 REQUEST THAT this Court enter the Parties’ accompanying proposed order
23 setting the agreed-upon briefing schedule for Plaintiffs’ Preliminary Injunction
24 Motion and Defendants’ Motion to Dismiss.
