**ORDER**


As announced at the conclusion of the bench trial, the parties' proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, limited to 50 pages (using 13 point font, including footnotes), are due no later than **January 24, 2018**. In addition to any legal authorities the parties wish to cite, the Court requests that they discuss the cases attached to this Order (many of which have different procedural or factual circumstances but may bear on the issues in this case). The Court will hear argument on **February 16, 2018 at 9:30 a.m.**, in Courtroom 10D and will then take the matter under advisement. Any motions not ruled on at the final pretrial conference or during the trial are carried with the case and will be resolved through the Court's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.<sup>1</sup> The undersigned will visit Allen D.
