1 **STIPULATION REGARDING BRIEFING SCHEDULE**

2 The parties agree, subject to the Court’s approval, to modify the briefing schedules for
3 Plaintiffs’ Motion to Stay Implementation of the Court’s October 17, 2017 and November 16,
4 2017 Orders in Order to Resolve the Pending Motions Without Further Interlocutory Appeals by
5 Defendants (ECF No. 190) and Defendants’ Emergency Motion to Stay Discovery and Record

17 authorized him to file this stipulation on behalf of all plaintiffs.
