1 Plaintiffs appreciate the Court’s prompt attention to their motion for stay. The Court’s tentative
2 order, which provides the government ample time to compile the completed administrative record,
3 relieves any purported need for Supreme Court review at this stage, and properly focuses the next phase
4 of the case on resolving plaintiffs’ pending motion for provisional relief and defendants’ pending motion
5 to dismiss. Plaintiffs would propose the following adjustments to the Court’s tentative order:

6 Rather than setting a date certain for the filing of the completed administrative record, the Court
7 should require that the record be filed within seven days after the Court rules on the government’s
8 motion to dismiss and the plaintiffs’ motion for provisional relief. This will ensure that the Court’s
9 findings regarding the government’s pretext and bad faith, and regarding the government’s jurisdictional
10 defenses, will be entered prior to the filing of the administrative record. This would eliminate the
11 government’s argument that record completion is premature before these findings are made. If the Court
12 were to agree with plaintiffs (a) that the stated reasons for the rescission of DACA are pretextual; and
13 (b) that the government’s threshold jurisdictional defenses are ill-founded, then there would no longer be
14 any plausible argument against the expanded record the Court has correctly ordered. *See Citizens to*
15 *Preserve Overton Park, Inc. v. Volpe*, 401 U.S. 402, 420 (1971) (authorizing supplementation of record
16 in APA claims, including “inquiry into the mental process of administrative decisionmakers,” where
17 there is a “strong showing of bad faith or improper behavior”).
