**DEFENDANTS' MEMORANDUM IN RESPONSE TO PLAINTIFF JOHN DOE'S  
MOTION TO PROCEED THROUGH PSEUDONYM**

Plaintiffs have moved first to permit plaintiff John Doe to proceed with this suit through pseudonym and second to allow all individual plaintiffs to omit their home addresses from the caption of the Complaint. *See* Pls.' Mot. at ECF No. 8-1. Defendants do not oppose the relief sought in plaintiffs' motion, subject to two conditions, articulated below and reflected in the attached proposed order.

**I. John Doe's Request to Proceed Anonymously**

Plaintiff John Doe is a 25-year-old transgender male who is a Senior Airman in the United States Air Force at Little Rock Air Force Base, Arkansas, and he seeks to proceed in this action anonymously out of concern for his safety and the safety of his girlfriend. *See* Compl. ¶¶ 24-25; Pls.' Mem. at 3. Defendants do not oppose that request, on the condition that plaintiffs' counsel provide the identity of plaintiff John Doe and the under seal filings in support of plaintiffs' motion to defendants, who will (a) use that information only for purposes of defending this litigation, and (b) not disseminate that information publicly.

## II. Plaintiffs' Request to Omit Home Addresses from Complaint

All individual plaintiffs request the omission of their home addresses from the caption of the Complaint out of concern that “[p]roviding their home address in the caption will dramatically increase the scope of potential harassment and violence directed at Individual Plaintiffs and their families . . . .” Pls.’ Mem. at 5. Defendants do not oppose this request on the condition that plaintiffs inform defense counsel of any changes to the individual plaintiffs’ allegations of residence in the Complaint, *see, e.g.*, Compl. ¶¶ 11, 19, 25, 33, 40, 46.

### CONCLUSION

Defendants do not oppose plaintiffs’ motion provided that they receive the information, indicated above, that they may need to defend this case.

**[PROPOSED] ORDER**

Plaintiffs' Motion for John Doe to Proceed under Pseudonym and to Omit Individual Plaintiffs' Home Addresses from the Caption of the Complaint, ECF No. 8-1, having come before the Court, and the Court having considered that motion, that motion is GRANTED subject to the terms below.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that plaintiff John Doe may proceed through a pseudonym, *provided that* through counsel, John Doe provides his identity (along with documents that have been filed under seal in this matter) to undersigned defense counsel of record, who will use and share John Doe's identity with defendants and other persons only as needed to defend this litigation, and will not disclose John Doe's identity publicly.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each of the individual plaintiffs may omit their home addresses from the caption on the Complaint *provided that* the individual plaintiffs inform defense counsel of any changes to the individual plaintiffs' residences that occur during the pendency of this litigation.
