1. The court will continue the evidentiary hearing on the plaintiffs’ motion for a preliminary injunction on **Monday, July 31, 2017, at 9:30 a.m.** at the Holmes Building, 101 Larry Holmes Drive, 4th Floor, Easton, Pennsylvania 18042;¹

¹ Counsel shall notify the court as promptly as possible whether they anticipate presenting any testimony other than the continued testimony of Dr. Leibowitz on this date.

2. The final day of the evidentiary hearing on the motion for a preliminary injunction will occur on **Monday, August 7, 2017, at 9:30 a.m.** at the Holmes Building, 101 Larry Holmes Drive, 4th Floor, Easton, Pennsylvania 18042;²

3. The parties may file supplemental findings of fact (preferably with citations to the evidence in the record) and conclusions of law by no later than **Thursday, August 10, 2017, at 6:00 p.m.**; and

4. The court will hear oral argument on the motion for a preliminary injunction on **Friday, August 11, 2017, at 2:00 p.m.** at the Holmes Building, 101 Larry Holmes Drive, 4th Floor, Easton, Pennsylvania 18042.
