12 requested a ruling on the Motion as soon as possible and no later than May 23, 2018;

13 WHEREAS, on March 30, 2018, the Court issued an order setting a briefing
14 schedule and a hearing on the Motion for May 14, 2018 at 9:00 a.m. [Docket No. 89];

15 WHEREAS, pursuant to the briefing schedule, Plaintiffs and Plaintiff-
16 Intervenor filed their joint opposition to the Motion [Docket No. 98] on April 25,
17 2018, and Defendants filed their reply in support of the Motion [Docket No. 105] on
18 May 7, 2018;

19 WHEREAS, on May 9, 2018, the Court vacated the May 14, 2018 hearing and
20 ordered the parties to meet and confer to discuss a mutually agreeable date for a
21 hearing, selected from one of the following dates: June 4, June 25, July 2, July 9, July
22 16, or July 23; and

23 WHEREAS, (i) the Parties have meet and conferred, (ii) Defendants sought to
24 reschedule the hearing in June, but (iii) the only date that works for all counsel is July
25 23, 2018.
