**UNOPPOSED MOTION TO EXTEND TIME  
TO FILE REQUEST FOR ATTORNEYS' FEES AND BILL OF COSTS**

Defendant Rent-A-Center East, Inc. ("RAC") files this unopposed motion to extend time to file its request for attorneys' fees and bill of costs as follows:

Local Rule 54.1 provides that requests for attorneys' fees must be filed no later than 14 days after entry of judgment, and that bills of costs must be filed within 30 days after entry of judgment. Judgment in this case was entered in favor of RAC on May 18, 2018. Dkt. # 110. Accordingly, under Rule 54.1, RAC's request for attorneys' fees is due June 1, 2018, while its bill of costs is due on June 18, 2018. This case was pending for 22 months, with extensive discovery conducted during that time. In addition, counsel for RAC has professional and personal commitments during the short time allowed by the Rules. Therefore, RAC respectfully requests a short extension of time to file its requests for fees and costs in order to gather all relevant documentation and present it to the Court in a clear and complete fashion.

Accordingly, RAC requests that the Court extend the time to file its request for attorneys' fees by 30 days until July 2, 2018, and extend the time to file its bill of costs until that same date.
