**UNOPPOSED MOTION BY THE STATE
OF NEBRASKA TO EXTEND TIME IN
WHICH TO FILE AMICUS BRIEF**

The State of Nebraska respectfully moves for a 14-day extension of time, to and including February 9, 2018, in which to file an amicus brief in support of the Appellants. This request is contingent on the Court's granting the parties' joint motion for an extension of the Appellees' briefing time. All parties consent to this motion.

1. The Appellants filed their brief on January 19, 2018. Pursuant to Fed. R. App. P. 29(a)(6), the deadline for filing an amicus brief in support of the Appellants is currently January 26, 2018. Pursuant to the same rule, the Court "may grant leave for later filing, specifying the time within which an opposing party may answer."

2. The State of Nebraska intends to submit an amicus brief to present its interests in this Court's adjudication of this case, but requires additional time to prepare its arguments. The undersigned has consulted with all counsel of record to

reach a stipulation on the extension of the briefing schedule. The parties consent to a 14-day extension of the State's amicus brief deadline, contingent upon the Court's granting the Appellees a corresponding 14-day extension of time in which to file their brief.

3. This extension request is made in the interests of justice and not to unnecessarily delay the adjudication of this matter.
