DEFENDANTS' CONSENT MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

Defendants hereby file this consent motion for an extension of seven (7) days, to and including Friday, June 15, 2018, to file their response to Plaintiffs' Cross-motion for Summary Judgment, ECF No. 163, and reply in support of Defendants' Motion to Dismiss Plaintiffs' Second Amended Complaint, or, in the Alternative, for Summary Judgment, ECF No. 158. In support thereof, Defendants state as follows:

1. Plaintiffs filed their Second Amended Complaint on April 27, 2018. ECF No. 148.
2. Defendants filed their Motion to Dismiss Plaintiffs' Second Amended Complaint, or, in the Alternative, for Summary Judgment ("Defendants' Motion") on May 11, 2018. ECF No. 158.
3. Plaintiffs filed their opposition to Defendants' Motion and cross-moved for summary judgment ("Plaintiffs' Motion") on May 25, 2018. ECF 163.
4. Under Local Rule 105.2(a), Defendants have fourteen (14) days from service of Plaintiffs' Motion and Plaintiffs' opposition to Defendants' Motion to file their response and reply.

Defendants' response to Plaintiffs' Motion and reply in support of Defendants' Motion are due June 8, 2018.

5. Because of deadlines in other cases, including two filings due on June 6, 2018, in the related case *Doe v. Trump*, 17-1597 (D.D.C.), Defendants need an additional seven (7) days, until Friday, June 15, 2018, to file their response to Plaintiffs' Motion and reply in support of Defendants' Motion.

6. Defense counsel has conferred with Plaintiffs' counsel regarding this motion, and Plaintiffs consent to the requested extension, provided that Plaintiffs are also granted an additional seven (7) days to file their reply in support of Plaintiffs' Motion, to and including Friday, July 6, 2018.

WHEREFORE, Defendants respectfully request that the Court enter an order extending the time (1) for Defendants to file their response to Plaintiffs' Motion and reply in support of Defendants' Motion until Friday, June 15, 2018, and (2) for Plaintiffs to file their reply in support of Plaintiffs' Motion until Friday, July 6, 2018.
