- 3) Rent-A-Center does not waive its right to submit a bill of taxable costs, but the parties agree that the amount awarded will not be less than \$12,000.00 and will not exceed \$30,000.00. The parties are currently attempting to reach a resolution on the cost issue and should the parties reach an agreement about an award of taxable costs, they will inform the Court and Clerk's office promptly.
