**ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' MOTION TO FILE UNDER SEAL
EXHIBITS F & G TO PLAINTIFFS' MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF
PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**

AND NOW, this 19th day of July 2018, having reviewed the submissions regarding Plaintiffs' Motion to File Under Seal Exhibits F and G, this Court **GRANTS** the motion, **FINDING** that: (1) Plaintiffs provided sufficient notice of the request; (2) that there are no less drastic alternatives than sealing the declarations; and (3) that declarants have a legitimate fear of discrimination based on their HIV status if their identities became public. Therefore, the Court **ORDERS** the Exhibits F and G to Plaintiffs' Memorandum in Support of Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction be filed under seal.
