20 Plaintiff Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC) moves this Court, pursuant to
21 Local Civil Rule 6-3, for an Order to continue the Initial Case Management Conference (CMC) currently
22 scheduled for August 22, 2017 at 1:30 p.m. [Dkt No. 4.] to September 19, 2017 at 1:30 p.m.

23 Good cause exists for the continuance of the CMC. First, Adrian Scott Duane notified the parties
24 of his intention to file a motion to intervene as Plaintiff-Intervenor this week. Defendant IXL Learning,
25 Inc. intends to oppose this motion. Continuing the Initial Case Management Conference allows this
26 Court time to determine the appropriate parties in this action. Second, on August 22, 2017, EEOC's lead
27 counsel, Ami Sanghvi, will be out of town on vacation in Oregon and is not scheduled to return until
28 August 23rd. Ms. Sanghvi cannot change the dates of the trip because the purpose of the trip is to view
the solar eclipse scheduled for August 21, 2017 and she cannot return in time for the CMC.

Plaintiff's counsel has conferred with Defendant's attorney regarding the proposed change.

1 Defendant's attorney is unavailable on August 29, 2017, the next available calendar date for this Court's
2 Initial Case Management Conferences. The next available date appears to be September 19, 2017.
3 Defendant indicated they do not oppose the motion for a continuance to this date.

4 Plaintiff respectfully requests this Court grant the instant request and continue the CMC to
5 September 19, 2017 at 1:30 pm.
