ORDER ON DISCOVERY LETTER

Re: Dkt. No. 55

On April 10, 2018, the court held a hearing on the Discovery Letter Brief re Third Party Subpoenas (Doc. 55). Based on the briefing and arguments made at the hearing and for the reasons stated at the hearing the court finds that the subpoenas may be issued and enforced, but must first be modified to be limited in scope as to communications between the third party and Mr. Duane concerning, relating to, describing, or discussing: Mr. Duane's employment at IXL; and Mr. Duane's employment opportunities following his employment at IXL, including communications related to his job search and any applications and/or offers for employment between January 8, 2015 and January 1, 2016.

Defendant shall have until April 20, 2018, by which to serve the third party subpoenas.
