1 Plaintiff U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC) and Plaintiff-Intervenor  
 2 Adrian Scott Duane filed a Joint Motion for Partial Summary Judgment on July 19, 2018 (ECF 68).  
 3 Defendant IXL Learning, Inc. (IXL), opposed Plaintiffs' motion and also filed a Motion for  
 4 Summary Judgment on August 2, 2018 (ECF 70-71). Plaintiffs' opposition/reply brief is due on  
 5 Thursday, August 16, 2018. This Court's Standing Order for Civil Cases limits the opposition/reply  
 6 brief to twenty (20) pages. [Standing Order for Civil Cases before Judge Vince Chhabria at ¶29.]  
 7 Plaintiff and Plaintiff-Intervenor require additional space to appropriately address factual assertions

 9 pages.

 11 parties request an Order from this Court allowing Plaintiff and Plaintiff-Intervenor to file a twenty-  
 12 five (25) page Joint Memorandum of Law in Opposition to Defendant's Motion for Summary  
 13 Judgment and Reply in Support of Plaintiffs' Motion for Partial Summary Judgment.
