**UNOPPOSED MOTION TO AMEND THE PRE-TRIAL
SCHEDULING ORDER FOR RULE 26(A)(3) DISCLOSURES
AND MOTIONS IN LIMINE**

Pursuant to Federal Rule 16(b), Defendants respectfully request that the Court amend the scheduling order entered on August 23, 2018, to extend the deadline for Rule 26(a)(3) disclosures and motions in limine from September 5, 2018, to September 7, 2018. In support thereof, Defendants state as follows:

1. In the Court's original pre-trial scheduling order, the deadline for Rule 26(a)(3) disclosures and motions in limine was set for September 7, 2018. (Dkt. 37:5.)
2. Defendants planned discovery around that timeline, including deposing two of Plaintiffs' experts on August 22 and 23, 2018. The accelerated

deadline will make it challenging for Defendants to complete any contemplated motions in limine regarding these experts, especially given the Labor Day holiday on the Monday before the current September 5 deadline.

3. Defendants do not seek to move the deadline for responses to motions in limine, currently set for September 14, 2018.

4. Defendants have not previously requested any modifications of this deadline.

5. Defendants' counsel conferred with Plaintiffs' counsel and are authorized to state that Plaintiffs do not oppose the deadline extension requested in this motion.

Accordingly, Defendants request that the Court amend the August 23, 2018, scheduling order to extend the parties' deadline for Rule 26(a)(3) disclosures and motions in limine to September 7, 2018, from the original deadline of September 5, 2018.
