ORDER

PITMAN, United States Magistrate Judge:

A conference having been held in this matter on July 27, 2015, during which several discovery issues were discussed, for the reasons stated on the record in open court, it is hereby ORDERED that:

1. Plaintiff's First Document Request 9 is denied without prejudice. Plaintiff or his counsel are directed to contact Ms. Bodman regarding her appearance for a deposition. I also direct defendant to ascertain Ms. Bodman's employment status, if any, with Breitling. A conference call will be held on Monday, August 3, 2015 at 2:00 p.m. to determine whether a further application will be necessary with respect to scheduling Ms. Bodman's deposition.

2. Defendant is to produce the portions of the personnel files of the comparators identified by plaintiff that include performance reviews, sales performance, disciplinary/ misconduct reports, resumes to the extent that they reflect educational background and experience, compensation, self evaluations, and participation in marketing events.

3. Defendant is to produce the sales manager's files for the comparators identified by plaintiff to the extent the files contain information on performance reviews, sales performance, disciplinary and misconduct reports, resumes to the extent that they reflect educational background and experience, compensation, self evaluations, participation in marketing events, social or after-hours events.

4. Defendant is to produce W-2 forms for the comparators identified by plaintiff for the calendar years 2009 through 2013. Defendant may redact the social security numbers and home addresses from these forms.


5. Plaintiff's application for leave to serve more than 25 interrogatories is denied.

6. Plaintiff's objection to defendant's Document Request 34 is sustained.

7. Plaintiff's objections to defendant's Interrogatories 6-8 are overruled.
