**ORDER**

These matters are before the court on Lamda Legal's *Motion to Extend Time to File Amicus Brief in Support of Cross-Appellee Dr. Rachel Tutor*. Upon consideration, the motion is granted as modified by, and described in, this order.

As an initial matter, we note that while the motion suggests the other parties to these cross appeals have "essentially" consented to the request, that consent appears conditional, or potentially conditional. Therefore, while at this time we grant the request to file the proposed amicus curiae brief within 7 days after appellant/cross-appellee Rachel Tutor files the third brief on cross appeal, the brief must be accompanied by a

motion filed in accord with Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 29(a)(2). The motion seeking leave must also comply with all other provisions of Rule 29, including Rule 29(a)(3). Should any party object to submission of the proposed amicus brief, that opposition must be reflected in the motion.
