**STIPULATION TO EXTEND TIME TO FILE
MOTION FOR ATTORNEYS' FEES AND COSTS
AND BILL OF COSTS**

The Parties, by their attorneys, hereby stipulate to extend the deadlines for filing the motion and supporting pleadings for attorneys' fees and costs and the filing of the bill of costs in the above-captioned matter.

On October 11, 2018, this Court entered judgment on a jury verdict for Plaintiffs and permanently enjoined Defendants "from enforcing the exclusion of coverage for '[p]rocedures, services and supplies related to surgery and sex hormones associated with gender reassignment' from health insurance coverage provided to state employees." (Dkt. 240). Under Fed. R. Civ. P. 54(d), unless a court order provides otherwise, a claim for attorney fees and non-taxable costs is to be filed by motion no later than 14 days after entry of judgment. In this case, such a motion would be

due on October 25, 2018. However, Defendants may appeal the judgment to the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit.

Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 54, the parties stipulate and agree that the Plaintiffs shall file their motion for fees and costs and their bills of costs within 30 days after the time to appeal the judgment has elapsed, or, if Defendants appeal, within 30 days after the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit has issued its mandate or the appeal is otherwise resolved.

As more fully set forth in the parties' Joint Motion for an Order Extending the Time to File Motion for Attorneys' Fees and Costs and to File Any Bill of Costs, filed herewith, the parties agree that the interests of justice, as well as interests of judicial economy, will be best served by holding all fee and cost issues in abeyance until after either the time to appeal has passed or any appellate proceedings are completed.
