MINUTE ORDER

ORDER ENTERED BY SENIOR JUDGE WILEY Y. DANIEL

On October 23, 2018, Plaintiffs filed a Motion for Preliminary Injunction ("Motion"), and attached exhibits to the Motion. (ECF No. 52). Excluding the caption page, the attorneys' signature page, and the certificate of service, the Motion is five pages long. Contemporaneous with the filing of the Motion, Plaintiffs also filed a Memorandum of Law in Support of Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction ("Memorandum"). (ECF No. 53). Excluding the caption page, the tables of contents and authorities, the attorneys' signature page, and the certificate of service, the

Memorandum is thirty pages long. Rather than filing separate motions and memoranda of law, the Court prefers that parties file a single document containing the entirety of the relief requested, the analysis, and the supporting legal authority. In any event, the combined thirty-five pages of the Motion and the Memorandum exceed the thirty-page limit I ordered on “the text of Plaintiffs’ motion for preliminary injunction.” (ECF No. 20). Therefore, Plaintiffs’ Motion and Memorandum are **STRICKEN**. Plaintiffs may refile the Motion and the Memorandum as a single document whose text may not exceed thirty pages.
