1. Defendants shall file their opening brief and required short appendix in the main appeal docketed in 18-3408 on or before January 28, 2018.
2. Plaintiffs shall file their combined responsive brief in the main appeal and opening brief and appendix in cross-appeal docketed in 18-3485 on or before February 27, 2019.
3. Defendants shall file their combined reply brief, if any, in the main appeal and responsive brief in the cross-appeal on or before March 29, 2019.
4. Plaintiffs shall file their reply brief, if any, in the cross-appeal on or before April 12, 2019.

Important Scheduling Notice!

Notices of hearing for particular appeals are mailed shortly before the date of oral argument. Criminal appeals are scheduled shortly after the filing of the appellant's main brief; civil appeals after the filing of the appellee's brief. If you foresee that you will be unavailable during a period in which your particular appeal might be scheduled, please write the clerk advising him of the time period and the reason for such unavailability.
