Joint Motion to File Oversized Briefs

Pursuant to Tenth Circuit Rule 28.3(A), Defendants Southeastern Oklahoma State University and the Regional University System of Oklahoma, together with Plaintiff Rachel Tudor, respectfully move for permission to file two upcoming briefs with the following word limits, which go beyond the limits in Fed. R. App. P. 28.1(e):

- **Appellees/Cross-Appellants' Principal Brief:** 18,500 words (+3,200)
- **Appellants/Cross-Appellees' Response Brief:** 16,200 words (+3,200)

This modest request would extend each brief by less than 25 percent, and it is necessary for three reasons. *First*, each party is appealing at least three issues, meaning the two briefs encompassing both the appeal and cross-appeal will need to address and analyze six issues, if not more. *Second*, these issues are largely independent of each other—Plaintiff appeals several remedies questions, whereas Defendants are appealing
