**Plaintiff’s Statement of Claims**

Plaintiff, pursuant to the Order on Case Management Plan in this case (Dkt. 27), states that in this case he has the following claims against defendant (“EVSC”).

1. The failure of EVSC to allow J.A.W. to use male restrooms in its schools, prior to the Court’s preliminary injunction determination, represents intentional discrimination in violation of Title IX, 20 U.S.C. § 1681(a), and EVSC is therefore liable for plaintiff’s damages and the preliminary injunction should be made permanent.<sup>1</sup> Additionally, EVSC is liable for plaintiff’s costs and reasonable attorneys’ fees.
2. The failure of EVSC to allow J.A.W. to use male restrooms in its schools, prior to the Court’s preliminary injunction determination, was predicated on a sex-

<sup>1</sup> As of this date plaintiff has completed all course work in his senior year and anticipates receiving a diploma in the near future. However, EVSC officials have indicated that he may walk with his class for graduation in the Spring of 2019. He will therefore have to return to EVSC property for graduation and graduation rehearsal. The plaintiff’s request for a permanent injunction, if not resolved before that time, will be withdrawn after his graduation ceremony.

based, or otherwise improper, classification in violation of the Equal Protection Clause of the Fourteenth Amendment and EVSC is liable for plaintiff's damages and the preliminary injunction should be made permanent. Additionally, EVSC is liable for plaintiff's costs and reasonable attorneys' fees.

WHEREFORE, plaintiff files his Statement of Claims.
