

1 In light of the district court’s decision yesterday to stay the preliminary injunction in
2 *Stone v. Trump*, No 1:17-cv-02459-GLR (D. Md. Mar. 7, 2019) (ECF No. 249), there is no longer
3 any impediment to the military’s implementation of the Mattis policy. Defendants therefore
4 respectfully provide notice to the Court that the Acting Secretary of Defense plans to release a
5 Directive-Type Memorandum (DTM) formally implementing the new policy in the near future.
6 That DTM will not take effect until 30 days after its release. This plan is consistent with the
7 Supreme Court’s stay order. *Trump v. Karnoski*, No. 18A625 (U.S. Jan. 22, 2019); *see also*
8 *Trump v. Stockman*, No. 18A627 (U.S. Jan. 22, 2019).
