Joint Motion to Extend Deadline for Service of Final Witness and Exhibit Lists

The parties, by their counsel, say that:

1. Pursuant to the approved case management plan in this case (Dkt. 27), they are to serve their final witness and exhibits lists by April 22, 2019.
2. Plaintiff has filed a motion for partial summary judgment in this case (Dkt. 87) and the defendant has filed a cross-motion for summary judgment (Dkt. 95) as well as a motion to dismiss (Dkt. 83). These motions remain pending.
3. This matter has not yet been set for trial.
4. Assuming that the pending motions do not fully resolve this case, the parties believe that a resolution of the motions may radically alter the witnesses they would call and the exhibits they would offer in this case.
5. The parties therefore wish to wait until resolution of the pending motions to serve their final witness and exhibit lists in this case.

WHEREFORE, the parties request that the time within which they must serve their final witness and exhibit lists be extended until 30 days after the Court's last ruling on the pending motion to dismiss and summary judgment requests, and for all other relief.
