In light of the district court’s decision yesterday to stay the preliminary injunction in *Stone v. Trump*, No 1:17-cv-02459-GLR (D. Md. Mar. 7, 2019) (ECF No. 249), there is no longer any impediment to the military’s implementation of the Mattis policy. Defendants therefore respectfully provide notice to the Court that the Acting Secretary of Defense plans to release a Directive-Type Memorandum (DTM) formally implementing the new policy in the near future. That DTM will not take effect until 30 days after its release. This plan is consistent with the Supreme Court’s stay order. *Trump v. Stockman*, No. 18A627 (U.S. Jan. 22, 2019); *see also Trump v. Karnoski*, No. 18A625 (U.S. Jan. 22, 2019).
