**ORDER**

The Court has reviewed Plaintiff's Motion to Seal, and the public memorandum filed in support thereof, *and the defendant's response thereto. RJL* Upon consideration of Plaintiff's motion and supporting memorandum, the Court hereby FINDS:

1. That public notice of the request to seal and a reasonable opportunity to challenge the request has been given;
2. That the targeted and limited sealing sought by Plaintiff is the least drastic alternative available; and
3. That the common law and First Amendment presumptions in favor of public access to records are outweighed for the reasons set forth in Plaintiff's public memorandum.

Accordingly, for good cause shown, it is hereby

ORDERED that Plaintiff's Motion to Seal is GRANTED; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk shall immediately and permanently seal Exhibits B, C, D, and E of Plaintiff's Reply Memorandum in Further Support of Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment.
