**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND
TO MOTION TO COMPEL**

The defendants, Lawrence J. Hogan, Jr., Governor, and Brian E. Frosh, Attorney General, move for an extension of time to file their response to the plaintiff’s motion to compel and, as reasons, state:

1. The plaintiff, Christopher Doyle, LPC, LCPC, served his motion to compel on April 11, 2019. Under the Court’s scheduling order, the response to that motion is due Thursday, April 25, 2019.

2. Counsel responsible for preparing the response to the plaintiff’s motion has been ill, and the undersigned counsel has had other obligations that precluded her from taking over the preparation of the response.

3. The undersigned counsel requested a week’s extension of time to respond to the plaintiff’s motion, and the plaintiff’s counsel consented to that request.
