8 Plaintiffs Aiden Stockman, Nicolas Talbott, Tamasyn Reeves, Jaquice Tate,
9 John Does 1-2, Jane Doe, Equality California, and Plaintiff-Intervenor the State of
10 California (collectively, “Plaintiffs”) and Defendants Donald J. Trump, Patrick M.
11 Shanahan, Joseph F. Dunford, Jr., Richard V. Spencer, Mark T. Esper, Heather A.
12 Wilson, and Kevin K. McAleenan (collectively, “Defendants,” and, along with
13 Plaintiffs, the “Parties”) by and through their respective counsel, hereby stipulate as
14 follows:

15 WHEREAS, Plaintiffs filed the above-captioned action on September 5, 2017
16 (ECF No. 1);

17 WHEREAS, on July 30, 2018, the Court entered the Civil Trial Scheduling
18 Order (ECF No. 116), establishing a case schedule;

19 WHEREAS, in February 2019, the Parties stipulated that good cause existed
20 to modify the case schedule;

21 WHEREAS, on February 15, 2019, this Court entered the Order on Joint
22 Stipulation to Modify Case Schedule (ECF No. 144);

23 WHEREAS, on May 6, 2019, Plaintiffs filed motions to vacate the scheduling
24 order (ECF Nos. 150 & 151);

25 WHEREAS, on May 13, 2019, Defendants filed an opposition to Plaintiffs’
26 motions to vacate the scheduling order (ECF No. 152);

27 WHEREAS, the next deadline set forth in the scheduling order is the May 24,
28 2019 deadline for the initial designation of expert witnesses;

1 WHEREAS, Plaintiffs suggested that the May 24, 2019 deadline be continued
2 in light of the pending motions to vacate the scheduling order, and represented that
3 if the Parties were unable to reach agreement, then they were prepared to file an ex
4 parte application requesting that relief;

5 WHEREAS, Defendants maintain their opposition to Plaintiffs' motions to
6 vacate the scheduling order, and intend to serve their experts designations on May
7 24, 2019, in compliance with the current scheduling order; and

8 WHEREAS, in order to avoid the need for the Court to decide a contested ex
9 parte application, the Parties have agreed to a continuation from May 24, 2019 to
10 June 24, 2019 of Plaintiffs' deadline to make their initial designation of expert
11 witnesses. THEREFORE, THE PARTIES STIPULATE, AGREE, AND JOINTLY
12 REQUEST THAT this Court continue the deadline for Plaintiffs to make their initial
13 designation of expert witnesses from May 24, 2019 to June 24, 2019.
