**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO REPLY

1. The defendants, Lawrence J. Hogan, Jr., Governor, and Brian E. Frosh, Attorney General, served their motion to dismiss on March 8, 2019; the plaintiff, Christopher Doyle, LPC, LCPC, served his response in opposition to the motion to dismiss on April 22, 2019. Under the Court’s scheduling order, the reply to that motion is due Monday, April 29, 2019.

2. The undersigned counsel mistakenly assumed that the reply would be due two weeks after the opposition, i.e., on or before May 6, 2019, and misread the scheduling order setting the due date for the reply on April 29, 2019.
