**ORDER RE COMMUNICATION FROM COUNSEL, VACATING
DECEMBER 14, 2018 STATUS CONFERENCE AND DEEMING
WITHDRAWN/DENYING AS MOOT PLAINTIFFS' MOTION TO
COMPEL RELATIVE TO FED. R. CIV. P. 30(B)(6) TOPIC NO. 5**

On December 11, 2018, the Court deferred ruling on Plaintiff's Motion to Compel relative to Fed. R. Civ. P. 30(b)(6) Topic No. 5 for the purpose of allowing the parties further to meet and confer regarding the same, and scheduled a telephonic status conference for this date at 8:00 a.m. to resolve any remaining dispute regarding the same, subject to such conference being vacated if Plaintiffs' and Defendants' counsel both notified the Clerk that such conference was unnecessary. As the Clerk has now been notified by counsel that they have resolved their disputes relative to Fed. R. Civ. P. 30(b)(6) Topic No. 5 and that a status conference this date is unnecessary, the Court vacates today's status conference and deems Plaintiff's Motion to Compel relative to Fed. R. Civ. P. 30(b)(6) Topic No. 5 withdrawn/denies the motion as moot relative to the same.
