ORDER

For the reasons stated in the accompanying Memorandum Opinion, defendants' Rule 72 Objections to Magistrate Judge's Nondispositive Ruling [Dkt. No. 137] are SUSTAINED IN PART and OVERRULED IN PART, the magistrate judge's Order [Dkt. No. 128] is AFFIRMED IN PART and REVERSED IN PART, plaintiffs' Motion to Compel Documents and Information Withheld on the Basis of the Deliberative Process Privilege [Dkt. No. 108] is GRANTED IN PART and DENIED IN PART, and it is hereby

ORDERED that defendants produce to plaintiffs all of the 330 remaining contested documents except to the extent those documents form part of the predecisional, deliberative process related to the ongoing policy revision of AR 600-110; and it is further

ORDERED that no later than Friday, May 31, 2019, defendants submit for in camera review every document they believe may be withheld as relating to the AR 600-110 policy revision, along with an appropriately detailed privilege log.

The Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Order to counsel of record.
