Dear Judge Dearie,

I write on behalf of Defendants in the above-mentioned case to request a short adjournment of the status conference currently scheduled for April 24, 2019. This is Defendants' first request to adjourn the status conference; Plaintiff's counsel consents. This request is necessitated because the undersigned must be in Portland, Oregon the day before the status conference for a preliminary injunction hearing involving numerous parties. I am concerned that my travel home will interfere with my ability to participate in the status conference in this case, and so request a very brief adjournment, to which Plaintiff has consented. If the Court is amenable to changing the date, the parties are available any time on April 25, April 29, or April 30, 2019

In addition, the parties note that the Court's order of March 14 setting the status conference referred to a "telephonic status conference" and directed counsel for Plaintiff to arrange a teleconference with a call-in number and access code (which counsel for Plaintiff has done), but also specified a courtroom (Courtroom 10A). Accordingly, the parties respectfully request clarification as to whether the Court is equally open to in-person appearance by those for whom that would be convenient, or would prefer that this conference be telephonic for simplicity.
