Latimer, and hereby submit this Joinder in IDOC's Defendants' Motion for Extension of Time to Respond to Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunction and Request for Status Conference ("Motion for Extension of Time") filed June 4, 2018. [Dkt. No. 63].

The Corizon Defendants incorporate and adopt herein by reference the entirety of the IDOC Defendants' Motion for Extension of Time, as well as the Memorandum in Support. [Dkt. No. 63-1]. For the reasons the IDOC Defendants provide therein, there is good cause to provide the IDOC Defendants a minimum of six months in which to conduct discovery, retain expert witnesses, and prepare a full and complete response to Plaintiff Adree Edmo's Motion for Preliminary Injunctive Relief. [Dkt. No. 62]. Those same reasons provide good cause to grant the Corizon Defendants the same extension. As discussed by the IDOC Defendants, this litigation involves complicated factual and medical issues, as well as legal issues of first impression in Idaho. Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunction substantively addresses those issues, including with expert testimony. At this time, however, the parties have not yet exchanged initial disclosures, conducted any discovery, or taken any depositions. Both the Court and the parties, including Plaintiff, would benefit from informed and substantive briefing regarding Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunctive Relief.

For all of the reasons articulated by the IDOC Defendants, the Corizon Defendants join in the IDOC's Motion for Extension of Time, and request an extension of equal length in which to respond to Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunctive Relief.
