Dear XY from Z,

Thank you for your kind letter and words of support. I am happy to hear my writings have been of some help and encouragement to you.

I agree that the 12 step programs only address the addictive aspects of SSA which is really only the manifestation of deeper emotional trauma and unfulfilled developmental needs.

I don't think that 12 step programs get to the root of the problem and I suggest you find a good Reparative Therapist in Israel. They may be intimidated to call themselves Reparative Therapists but I know that they apply my techniques because I supervise them. I would be happy to recommend a few names if you are interested.

We actually have a new technique that targets the addictive behavior and this technique has been shown to be very effective. While that can be done in isolation of regular therapy, I suggest it be applied within the context of on-going sessions to clear out the root of the problem, as I have stated above.

Once we have significantly diminished the behavior and motivations of SSA, we can apply techniques to actually develop and build up OSA.

I like your penetrating questions and I like your intellectual approach to these problems. Smart guy!

You don't have to worry about "de-familiarizing himself from the feminine because already he is not a female. His femininity is an imitation femininity, not authentic from his true nature. Once we diminish the SSA, the client begins to feel and believe in his natural masculinity. That becomes the basis of his viewing woman as "other than himself," from which the attraction develops.

Of course, if you read my book *Shame and Attachment Loss* you will read more about the details of what I have just tried to explain in very basic terms.

I hope this response helps you and more importantly, encourages you to keep on going and not be discouraged by the liberal media nonsense.

Hi, there, always very nice to hear from you! Hope things are getting better on your end now that the storm has passed, sigh.

I want to thank you for your offer. Alan has been after me for quite some time to get involved with their ministry/program. I have tried to help as I am able, but I have very serious limitations.

My greatest limitation is political. I do not want what occupies 1% of my time to take up 95% of it, and with the activist movement being what it is in Brazil, I want to stay away from them. There is a real risk that I could get my license revoked and I just don't want to go there. Alan understands this, yet he continues to insist.

I also have time constraints. My husband has retired, and at this point I am the breadwinner, so I am involved in a lot of clinical training. I'm also trying to get organized for retirement, that is, work LESS!

I have offered Alan a lot of tools, workbooks, suggestions, etc. He also asked to come to Brasilia for some intensive therapy and eventually backed out even though I had made arrangements for a very special price.

Anyway, all that to say that I really can't move forward with the project, although I certainly see a great need for it. Alan seems to think I am the only person who can do these things, and I'm sure there are other very capable people.

My darling daughter has now given me two wonderful grandchildren. [Redacted] will be 6 next week, and [Redacted] turned 3 in January. They are a great joy in my life. They live a 3 minutes' walk away and come over almost every day. Just delightful. [Redacted] is finishing a post-doc at the University here. I think she is brilliant, but who am I to say? But she is brilliant, and loving and just a wonderful mother. [Redacted] is doing well. The Brazilian economy has its ups and downs and last year was a difficult one for them, but this one seems to have started up well.

Christopher Rosik, David Pickup, and National Task Force for Therapy Equality,

I just read in the American Psychological Association's May 2017 issue of the *Monitor on Psychology*, p. 50, in the bottom bar, the following statement:

ARE PRACTITIONERS BECOMING MORE ETHICAL?

The results of research presented at APA's 2016 Annual Convention suggest that today's practitioners are less likely to commit such ethical violations as kissing a client, altering diagnoses to meet insurance criteria and treating homosexuality as pathological than their counterparts 30 years ago.

I have never heard that the APA has declared that treating homosexuality as pathological is unethical. Is that right? I believe if they had done so, we would have sued them to the wall for restraint of trade. I think this is an error, and we should demand that the APA publishes an errata in the *Monitor*.

I think we should start by asking for clarification nicely—by having APA members email the ethics committee first for clarification. We can go from there to ask for an errata to be published. If not satisfied, we can bring in an attorney to demand an errata be published or take whatever steps legal council advises. But we cannot let this statement just stand.

Do we have any members of the American Psychological Association who would sign on to this besides David Pickup, Christopher Rosik, my friend Elizabeth Kim if she wishes, and myself?

Men,

We've had to make a couple of staff changes. Redacted have had to drop due to unforeseen scheduling conflicts at work. We haven't been able to recruit a new co-leader, so Redacted and I will be informally picking up portions of that role in support of Redacted while continuing our regular roles as Lead MOS (Redacted) and Spirit Guide (me). Redacted will be joining us as a new Man of Service, although he won't be able to arrive until late Thursday evening. He has staffed three times before, so he'll be a great addition to the team.

I'm attaching an updated staff list.

Also, with Redacted having to step down, I'm not sure who has filled out their integrity questionnaires and who hasn't. If you haven't yet, please answer the questions in the attached Word document and send them to me with a copy to Redacted. If you already sent your answers to Redacted, reply to me by email and let me know that. Thank you.

Additionally, the following documents are in the JiM Weekend Dropbox folder, but I'm attaching them here for your convenience.

These first two are documents that you need to print out, sign, and bring with you:

- 1) Agreements and Liability Release
- 2) Staff Code of Ethics

The next one -- Guidelines for Golden Father Holding -- is not a separate document for you to sign. I'm just sending it for you to read and remind you of your commitments. Holding Guidelines are guidelines for journeyers but are COMMITMENTS for staff.

Some additional reminders:

- 1) Bring a complete printed copy of the protocol, 2017 edition, printed out from Dropbox. No sharing with other staff. Don't bring an older copy (which you shouldn't have kept anyway). If you want to bring a digital copy on a tablet, clear it with Bruce first. We normally want to minimize the use of electronic devices, especially in front of the journeyers.
- 2) Make sure **Redacted** knows what your travel plans are (how you're getting to Deer Park, who you're traveling with, etc.)
- 3) Make sure you've paid your staff fee if you committed in your staff application that you would. If you have questions, contact me.
- 4) Bring your JiM seed pouch. If you can't find it, you can buy a new one from Brothers Road for \$10.
- 5) Bring a sleeping bag or sheet and blanket(s). Bring a pillow. The site does not provide bedding.
- 6) Bring a towel, soap, shampoo and toiletries.
- 7) Optional: Bug spray, flashlight.

That's all I can think of at the moment. There may be more later.

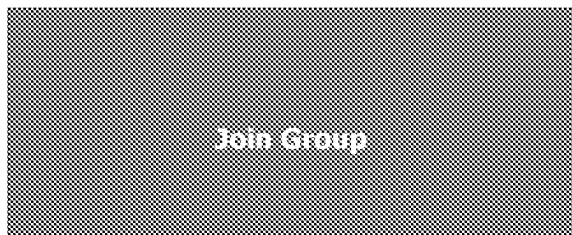

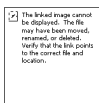

I trust you had a powerful experience at Journey Into Manhood this past week. A powerful workshop can be a dramatic turning point in a man's life, but of course there remains much work to do. The journey always continues.

Here are some things to help you continue with the community, support and healing work you've started:

- 1) We've created a private, secret Facebook group just for the men who participated (as journeyers or staff-volunteers) in the Journey Into Manhood program last week. JiM Volunteer Staff:

Expectations & Minimum Requirements

Staffing a Journey Into Manhood weekend can be extremely rewarding. But it also requires men to step up in many ways -- by giving service, being accountable, and by maintaining their sexual integrity and confidentiality commitments, for example.

Following are the minimum requirements and expectations of staff.

1. JiM Graduates -- With few exceptions, staff men are Journey Into Manhood "grads" themselves. (On occasion, a man who has not been through Journey Into Manhood himself may be invited to staff if he brings particular gifts - such as guts facilitation skills - or is, for instance, a therapist or ministry leader who may be a referral resource for potential future journeyers.)

2. Integrity Commitments

- Confidentiality - All staff men must be in integrity with the confidentiality commitments they made on prior JiM weekends, either as journeyers or staff. AND they must be ready to re-affirm those commitments going forward.
- Sexual Behavior - All staff men must be in integrity with the sexual integrity commitments they made on prior JiM weekends, either as journeyers or staff: specifically, to NEVER have any sexual or romantic involvement with ANY man through the Brothers Road network or any Brothers Road event. AND they must be ready to re-affirm those commitments going forward.
- Disclosure of Integrity Breaches - All staff men must honor the commitment they made at JiM to disclose to the Brothers Road executive director if they are aware of any man who has become involved sexually or romantically with any other man from any Brothers Road community or event.

This is essential to help ensure that men who are out of sexual integrity with our community and the Brothers Road organization are not placed in positions of trust within Brothers Road, until the issue is thoroughly resolved. It also gives the men in question an opportunity to look at their sexual-integrity shadows, be held accountable, and to do the work to get back in integrity with the Brothers Road community and the Brothers Road organization, if they so desire.

If a man has broken any of these commitments at any time in the past, he MUST receive clearance through Brothers Road and specifically the executive director (Rich Wyler) before he can be considered to staff again.

3. Sexual Sobriety Requirement

All staff men serving in Man of Service roles must have established a **minimum of 6 months** of abstinence from any homosexual contact with any other male (ANYONE, not just men from the Brothers Road community) by the time they submit their staff application.

All staff men serving in "Guide" roles must have established a **minimum of 2 years** of abstinence from any homosexual contact with any other male (ANYONE, not just men from the Brothers Road community) by the time they submit their staff application.

All staff men must be willing to answer honestly and candidly a short integrity questionnaire roughly 1-3 weeks before the weekend they will be staffing. This is to ensure that all staff men come to the weekend in integrity and in a state of sexual sobriety.

Please be aware that some men have had to step down from staffing at the last minute when they have "acted out" sexually with another man between the time they submitted their staff application and before the start of the weekend. So it is very important to consciously and deliberately maintain your sexual sobriety between now and then.

4. Signed Releases & Commitments -- As a staffer, you will be required to sign:

- The same liability release, confidentiality agreement, and "further agreements" document that the journeyers sign. Note that this includes the confidentiality and sexual-integrity commitments noted in No. 2, above. Read the document here.
- A staff ethics commitment, including an agreement to abide by the Brothers Road Golden Father Holding guidelines (formerly referred to as healthy holding or healthy touch) in all your interactions with other men from the Brothers Road community. (See articles at bottom of this email.)
- Or, if you have not always done so, that you will hold yourself accountable to the Weekend Leader and invite him to "Shadow check" you on why that is, and to check on the safety of any other man from Brothers Road with whom you might have done holding that does not follow the established guidelines.
- The staff ethics commitment emphasizes, among other things, that for 6 months after the JiM weekend:
 - you will not seek out journeyers from that weekend to get your own emotional or touch needs met
 - any further interactions you may have with those journeyers after the weekend will be driven primarily by them and will be focused on their needs and their healing journey, not yours
 - you will not be alone in a private setting, such as a car or a home, with a journeyer from that weekend
 - you will follow the Golden Father Holding Guidelines in all your interactions with other men from the Staffing a Journey Into Manhood weekend can be extremely rewarding. But it also requires men to step up in many ways -- by giving service, being accountable, and by maintaining their sexual integrity and confidentiality commitments, for example.

5. Travel Expenses -- Brothers Road asks all staff applicants whether they can pay some or all of their transportation expenses to and from the JiM weekend, and the staff-selection team gives preference to those who can pay their own travel expenses. However, we do not decline anyone's application solely based on his inability to pay his full transportation costs.

In any case, Brothers Road does not reimburse staff travel expenses for staff men who live within driving distance of the site (usually considered less than 6 hours' drive).

6. \$100 Staff Fee -- Brothers Road incurs a cost of, on average, about \$150 to \$200 for each man who staffs JiM. We charge a minimum \$100 staff fee to offset some of this cost. The fee can be waived, upon request, for men who cannot afford it, or for men who make regular or significant financial contributions to Brothers Road. We do not decline anyone's staff application based solely on his inability to pay the staff fee.

7. Time Commitment -- Staff men are required to arrive on site at the camp or retreat center (not the airport) at about 12 noon on the Thursday before the JiM weekend. Any exceptions must be pre-approved by the Weekend Leader.

Staff men are required to remain on site at the camp or retreat center until about 6 pm on the Sunday of the JiM weekend. Any exceptions to this departure time must be pre-approved by the Weekend Leader.

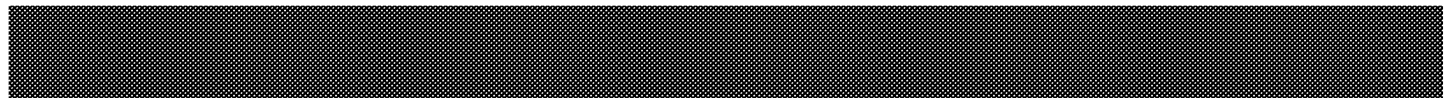
Staff men are expected to attend at least 2 pre-weekend conference calls. Men of Service and those involved in the Jack story each have at least one additional conference call.

Staff men are expected to help fill the weekend by inviting and encouraging appropriate men to attend, and "by spreading the word" and otherwise supporting outreach efforts.

Staff men are required to put in all the pre-weekend time necessary to fully prepare.

For Guides, that includes some memorization (especially those involved in the Jack story) and becoming so deeply familiar with the processes they lead that they can run their processes with little or no reference to the printed manual ("the protocol").

For Men of Service, it may mean significant involvement, as assigned, with collecting and organizing materials, arranging carpools, photocopying, running errands, making calls, supporting publicity and outreach, etc.



JiM Volunteer Staff Roles

In general, there are two types of staff: **Guides** and **Men of Service**. On your staff application, you can indicate whether you are most appropriate for and interested in serving as a Guide or a Man of Service, and which role specifically.

Guides

Guides are required to have at least 2 years of abstinence from homosexual involvement with other men.

Guides who have experienced SSA at any time in their life should have advanced far enough on their journey to be able to personally testify about the reality of change from unwanted same-sex attraction (in whatever way they may personally define "change"). Guides must be in a place on their journey where they could be considered a role model, in important ways, to men newer to the journey out of SSA.

Guides have typically staffed Journey Into Manhood a minimum of 3 to 5 times previously, and have also done other significant personal-growth or therapeutic work beyond the JiM weekend.

Guides lead and facilitate specific assigned processes of the weekend and at times take an active role in helping the journeyers to process their thoughts, feelings and overall experience. Typically, they also take a mid-level to senior-level role in co-facilitating "guts work."

Guide roles are:

1. Weekend Leader
2. Weekend Co-Leader
3. Spirit Guide
4. Elder
5. Leader Counsel
6. Jack
7. Shadow Guide
8. Teaching Guide
9. Materials & Facilities Lead ("Mat Fac")
10. Lead Guts Facilitator
11. Senior Guts Facilitator

Men of Service

Men of Service are required to have at least 6 months of abstinence from homosexual involvement with other men. Otherwise, they may be relatively new to the journey and relatively new to personal-growth or therapeutic work.

Men of Service typically have staffed Journey Into Manhood 0 to 5 times previously.

The primary role of Men of Service is to support the Guides and to provide logistical support and coordination to the overall event and to specific processes, as assigned.

Man of Service roles are:

1. Lead Man of Service (team leader)
2. Man of Service
3. Kitchen Man of Service (when meals are prepared by JiM staff and not by the camp)
4. Chef (when meals are prepared by Brothers Road/JiM)

Sound Man

The Sound Man is required to have at least 6 months of abstinence from homosexual involvement with other men. Otherwise, he may be relatively new to the journey and relatively new to personal-growth or therapeutic work.

Sound Men typically have staffed Journey Into Manhood 0 to 5 times previously.

The Sound Man sets up, runs and monitors the iPod-based sound system for the weekend and is responsible for related technical audio issues.

Sound Men typically have staffed Journey Into Manhood 0 to 5 times previously.



How JiM Volunteer Staff Are Selected

Usually, more men want to serve on staff than we can use. Brothers Road typically receives about 40 applications for 20 or so open positions. The most junior positions, staffed by first and second timers, have the most applicants.

For that reason, many men find that they may need to apply and be declined three or four times before they are selected to staff. This is especially true of men who have staffed fewer than five times. There is less "competition" for the more senior staff positions.

Please don't be discouraged by this reality; just keep applying. If your application is declined, it's nothing personal. It just means we have more applicants than we can use.

Staff selections are made by the Weekend Leader and Weekend Co-Leader, in consultation with Brothers Road Executive Director Rich Wyler (if Rich is not the Weekend Leader).

In reviewing applications, the team has a lot of important variables to consider. For example:

1. How many times previously has the applicant staffed? About half the staff needs to have staffed 5 or more times previously.
2. How many times has the applicant previously applied but been declined? If someone has been declined the last 3 or so times he's applied, we make a special effort to get him on staff, if possible.
3. Has he already staffed recently? We may need to give someone else an opportunity.

4. Has the applicant honored his prior sexual-integrity and confidentiality commitments that he made at Journey Into Manhood? Is he in integrity with Brothers Road?

5. How much "sexual sobriety" does he have (meaning, how long has it been, if ever, since he was homosexually involved with another man)?

6. Does he have specialized skills, expertise or relevant professional experience? We especially look for:

- strong, experienced "guts" facilitators and men who are gifted at "processing" others
- language skills (especially Spanish, in the US, Hebrew in Israel, or a diversity of languages, for the Europe weekend)
- medical professionals
- mental health professionals
- audio skills for sound man
- cooking skills for kitchen assistance, sometimes including kosher qualifications.

7. Does he carry the right "energy" for a particular Guide role? For example, the energy for "Jack" is quite different from "Elder"; and "Shadow Guide" is quite different from "Spirit Guide." For which role is the applicant a good match?

8. Does he have leadership skills? A number of roles -- Lead Man of Service, Mat Fac, Jack, and Co-Leader, for example -- require significant leadership ability.

9. Can he pay his own transportation costs plus the \$100 staff fee? This may be a "tie-breaker" consideration between two or more equally qualified applicants; however, Brothers Road does not decline anyone's staff application based solely on his inability to pay the staff fee or to pay his own transportation.

10. What, if anything, is his religious faith? His ethnic background or nationality? His age? We try to have as much diversity as feasible.

11. Where is he on his own personal journey, as a man?

12. How much passion does he have for this work?

13. Is he known to us, or to a trusted senior man within the Brothers Road community? Do we know that we can trust him, that he will be a hard worker, and is a man of integrity?

As you can see, there are a lot of variables to consider, so staff selection can be rather involved. Staff men are NOT chosen based on whether they are friends with the co-founders or the weekend leadership. It's not about "who do we like?" but "what do we need?" What skills, experience, talent, "energy," and diversity do we need on a particular weekend, and who among all the applicants is the best match for those needs?

Code of Ethics for Brothers Road Event Staff

As a member of the volunteer staff, I will uphold the standards and teachings of Brothers on a Road Less Traveled, and will encourage others to do likewise during the event and in any continuing contact I may have with fellow staffers or "journeymen" afterward.

I understand that the highly emotional and sensitive nature of the event, and my role as a staff member, may establish me as a role model or authority figure in the eyes of the Journeymen, and may make them more vulnerable to me than usual.

I therefore agree to abide by the following guidelines:

DURING THE EVENT

I agree:

- To respect Journeymen's boundaries. I will ask for permission before touching a Journeyman in an intimate way, such as a hug.
- To take responsibility for making known my own boundaries.
- If I experience feelings of sexual attraction toward or obsession with a Journeyman or staff man that could cause a problem for me or others, to process those feelings with a senior guide or leader.
- Not to engage in any homosexual activity, same-sex erotic touch or same-sex romantic flirtations of any kind.

AFTER THE EVENT

I agree:

- Never to engage in any sexual or romantic activity of any kind with any man who has ever been a participant in Journey Into Manhood or other Brothers Road events or communities. (This commitment precludes, in particular, any form of genital touch, even through clothing, but it also precludes, among other things, sexting, cybersex or any other sexual activity by phone, online or other media.)
- To follow the Golden Father Holding Guidelines, as taught by Brothers on a Road Less Traveled, in all my interactions with other men from the Brothers Road community. If I have not always done so, I will hold

myself accountable to the Weekend Leader and invite him to "Shadow check" me on why that is, and how it has affected the other man or men.

- Not to engage in one-to-one holding or one-to-one physical touch with a Journeyer in a private setting. If the Journeyer is in need of healthy holding, I may support him in creating a safe, small group setting, consistent with Brothers Road guidelines for Golden Father Holding.
- That if I sense a relationship developing a co-dependent or sexual nature, or if the Journeyer expresses concerns about the relationship, I will promptly seek the guidance of the man who was the event leader or co-leader.

I agree, for at least 6 months following the Brothers Road event, that I will adhere to the following guidelines in any interaction I have with a Journeyer from the weekend that I staffed (unless I had a pre-existing friendship with the other man).

- Any continuing connection will be initiated and driven primarily (but not necessarily exclusively) by the Journeyer, not by me.
- The focus of our contact will be primarily on the Journeyer's healing work, not mine.
- I will not seek to use a Journeyer to meet my own needs for affection, affirmation or holding.
- I will not be alone, one to one, in a private setting, such as a home or car, with a Journeyer. (This is exclusive of professional settings, such as a therapist's office, for staff who are mental health professionals.) If I meet alone with a Journeyer, I will do so in a place where others are present, or in a safe public setting, such as a restaurant.
- I will not engage in a financial partnership with a Journeyer, nor solicit business, sales or contributions from a Journeyer. I may, however, reactively accept a Journeyer as a client in a professional setting, as long as the contact is initiated by the Journeyer



Guidelines for "Golden Father Holding"

At Journey Into Manhood, we offer you an opportunity to receive affirming, safe, non-sexual touch. We call this "Golden Father Holding" in order to emphasize the healing potential of a "Golden Father" giving your "Inner Child" the unconditional love and acceptance that every innocent young boy desires and deserves. Golden Father Holding is safe, nonsexual, affirming, nonjudgmental and protective -- the way a loving father protects his son from being sexualized, wounded, or taken advantage of.

We offer Golden Father Holding only in sacred space. We are in a safe container. It is done in small groups, with others present. It is done fully clothed. It is done with healing intent. It is done after asking permission.

GUIDELINES

Brothers Road **STRONGLY urges you to follow the guidelines any time that you seek out Golden Father Holding**. In fact, Journey Into Manhood staff men are all asked to commit to follow these guidelines in their everyday lives as a condition of their eligibility to staff our weekends.

- Golden Father Holding is ALWAYS done with full permission of all participants.
- Golden Father Holding is done among THREE or more men, or with another man who has never experienced SSA. ***DO NOT ENGAGE IN HOLDING ONE-TO-ONE WITH ANOTHER SSA STRUGGLER IN A PRIVATE SETTING.***
- Golden Father Holding is ALWAYS done with healing intent-with one man clearly in the role of the loving, protective "Golden Father," and another man clearly in the role of the Inner Child, receiving nonsexual holding from his Golden Father and loving brothers.
- Golden Father Holding NEVER involves erotic touch, nor is it done in sexual positions (such as lying on top of each other) or places (such as on a bed).
- Golden Father Holding is done FULLY CLOTHED. Combining holding with nudity - even partial nudity (shirtless, for example) - can easily create an erotic context.
- Golden Father Holding is always done completely sober, never after drinking or using drugs.

INNER CHILD AND GOLDEN FATHER

Golden Father Holding is usually about meeting the needs and healing the wounds of the little boy. In order for holding to accomplish this, the man being held must make himself very vulnerable. And vulnerability sometimes creates sexual feelings.

Wounded little boys can't heal other wounded little boys. It takes Golden Father energy to heal a hurting boy. Golden Father energy is not sexual. An emotionally healthy father would never try to heal his son's wounds by having sex with him. That is abuse.

Golden Father energy is more safely created in conscious male communities of three or more men. Groups that include men without same-sex attraction can offer even greater safety and healing.

There have been some changes this year for Reparative therapy in Brazil, where we at Joel 2:25 have been able to help psychologists to get the right help to help people in search of change over SSA's unwanted feelings.

About Reparative Therapy we are a little better now, it is only very difficult to find qualified professionals. I talked to Dr. Nicolosi Junior, but he does not know any therapist who speaks Portuguese. Anyway, I'm grateful for your nominations.

I intend from now on to maintain a dialogue about how we can work together on creating a program, as I mentioned in the previous email, if there is any interest on your part. The program that Alan Downing has developed is actually something very good, but it does not address the needs related to the wounds and healing of the traumas and emotions on SSA, so intensely, with Journey Into ManHood (JIM) is able to do, so thinking about to get something that rescues manhood with a deeper look at SSA, is that Jeremy and I are looking for someone really willing to work to create a program similar to JIM.

Redacted gave me full autonomy to talk to you, or any other person who really is willing to do this to us.

In Brazil Joel 2:25 has taken a proportion far beyond a ministry. We are acting as a program, due to our differentiated methodology for example from Exodus, Courage and others who do not see Reparative Therapy as something so good. Esly Regina de Carvalho in Brasilia Redacted She works through EMDR to alleviate trauma and not specifically SSA (since i understand that targeting change of SSA specifically is illegal in Brazil---as opposed to dealing with the underlying issue that may have caused the condition, thereby permitting

someone to clear out their emotional "baggage".) EMDR is very effective in getting to the root cause(s) of the issues.

Rabbi Moshe Goldfeld in Sao Paulo; [Redacted] I met him at an AJOP (Association of Jewish Outreach Professionals) Convention several years ago in the USA, and in addition to being a rabbi, he informed me he is a mental health counselor.

Elisabeth Wajnryt in Sao Paulo; [Redacted] Worked with her many years ago concerning a Brazilian person who contacted me in my JONAH capacity. (By the way, I have a number of contacts of "strugglers" or "former strugglers" in my files.)

The most experienced person on the list above would be Esly Carvalho but since she is in Brazilia, you may wish to call her for recommendations of people in Sao Paulo or other locations within Brazil. Many many years ago, she was head of Exodus Latin America and is very familiar with SSA counseling. She also has a daughter who I believe practices as a mental health professional. I am not sure where in Brazil the daughter is. I also know the daughter as she spent time in the USA in the City in which I live.

Another possibility may be to work with Esly through a video conferencing format ilke Skype or by telephone rather than in-person since I believe Brazilia is far away from Sao Paulo. In her case particularly I suggest you mention that you would be looking for EMDR therapy for trauma that may have induced your SSA as opposed to saying that you are looking for SSA change therapy. Actually, it is probably a good idea to speak around the issue that way with all three (if my understanding is correct about the illegality of so-called reparative therapy in your country.)

I am happy to work with you in whatever way I can.

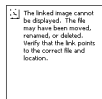

In addition to the financial harm I have suffered, the activists on the other side continue to denigrate my reputation with all sorts of "fake news." I no longer even try to correct the misinformation they convey. Nevertheless, on a positive note I am neither intimidated nor silenced and continue to speak out to the best of my ability. That is why I am willing to accept speaking engagements throughout the world and also to continue to write articles relevant to the subject. I also write on other important issues such as abortion, assisted suicide, and universal moral values. Could you please forward this email to the listserve? I lost my address book when I upgraded my pc operating system to Windows 10. :(I had a crazy Sukkos. I offered to help my Rabbi by picking up two bochurim (young single students men ffb religious-from-birth) from different bus stops at different times on the afternoon before the Holiday. One wanted to be picked up in **Redacted**. Not a good place for ssa strugglers to go because it's a known ssa "place". So I didn't want to hang out there waiting for his bus to show up. Got him to change to a **Redacted** suburb where there's a nice Jewish community **Redacted** but it was on the other side of town... oh well. The first two days the students led services because the regular two rabbis were in NYC.

Then comes the last two days. The older of the students was staying through the end of the holiday. He's 35, decent looking but single (so I assume he's got his issues) and not my type, no muscles (you know that shtick). But he offered to play catch football with me for awhile Sunday afternoon. So I thought, "Wow! Does he know something about Reparitive Therapy? ... and Journey Into Manhood?" Before I was in so much "pain" inside. I wanted to connect with him so badly (non-sexually) I desperately wanted a real hug from him. But I couldn't get it. He teaches semicha in **Redacted**. He probably knows what I just learned in the Rambam Mishneh Torah (one chapter per day schedule) Issurei Bia last two chapters... I can't embrace en ervah? Right? Usually it's a man-woman thing to prevent achem... but for those of us with ssa, are other men considered erva? I didn't want to ask either of the rabbis or the student; I didn't want to arouse suspicion. Paranoid?

Good news: I've been in the Jewish group "Guard Your Eyes" for awhile but not that active... I've been wanting to install filters for years now but hadn't known how to do the mechanics. So I talked with two other strugglers in another country: one was a member of this List. I got a clearer idea of what to do. Check into Venishmartem Cloud Filter (VCF). They offer pretty effective internet filtering either blocking altogether pictures or recognizing skin tones and changing the color to another color non-triggering. The filter won't let me go to P--trest or Google images (for example) (didn't want to spell out the name of the triggering site because I don't want to be responsible if any of you

take this information and use it for "self-abuse".) So my iPhone and pc laptop are under the VCF. It costs \$10 per month for iOS devices and \$13 per month for Windows PCs. My iPad is NOT covered cause I just can't afford it AND I caused it to "forget" the WiFi password here at home (95% of my acting out is at home and the rest in the parking lot at work in my car trying to be within range of the WiFi signal from work) (solitary crap)... though being transparent (spilling my guts) and not like the addict in Dr Carnes book (Out of the Shadows?) ... once in two different places during the same couple hours (after an after-the-meeting dinner and drinks with fellows from my 12-step SA group which went POORLY in my estimation... I wasn't focusing of the conversation but on what I was eating and when I tried to speak I either stuttered or had trouble "getting the words out"... very frustrating.) So after the fellas left, I sat in the parking lot next to a McDonalds WiFi trying to look at porn (very frustrating... very slow wifi) and then outside Starbucks (100 ft from the McDonalds place) although since I was practically the only car there after hours it felt creepy like I was a perv (G-d forbid) That wifi was a little better but not much :(Boy did I feel relieved when I got home and didn't get in trouble (It was 12:30 or 1:00AM !!!)

One more thing... in the synagogue today the two main rabbis got in an argument over "procedural issues". It must have somehow reminded me of my parents arguing when I was young and couldn't escape it. At the same time, my breathing was spasmodically going in and out (my chest and my abdomen) while I had all-of-a-sudden turned away from everyone facing the wall and started weeping uncontrollably. Soon after I tried to shut down my response since I was in public and didn't want to embarrass myself.

There's probably some good food-for-thought for me and my therapist to work on.

Sorry for such a long email. Hope you all had a good holiday.
