**ORDER**

Rule 5.2(a) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure provides that “[u]nless the court orders otherwise, in an electronic or paper filing with the court that contains . . . the name of an individual known to be a minor, . . . a party or nonparty making the filing may include only . . . the minor’s initials.” The complaint and subsequent documents filed on July 23, 2019, contain the full name of minor “S.M.,” in violation of Rule 5.2(a). The Court thus **ORDERS** the Clerk to seal the documents filed on July 23, 2019, and redact the minor’s name on the docket to “S.M.” The Court

**DIRECTS** Plaintiff to refile, on or before August 1, 2019, these documents with the minor's full name redacted from the filings.
