5 2. I have personal knowledge of all facts stated in this declaration, and if called to
6 testify, I could and would testify competently thereto.

7 3. Pursuant to Civil Local Rule 7-11(a), on June 3, 2019, I e-mailed Bradley Philip
8 Humphreys, Daniel Martin Riess, and R. Charlie Merritt, who are counsel of record on the matter
9 *State of California v. Azar*, 3:19-cv-01184-EMC (N.D. Cal.), to notify them that we intended to
10 file a preliminary injunction in the current case, to inquire if an attorney had been assigned to the
11 current case, and whether that attorney would agree to stipulate to California's motion for leave to
12 exceed the 25-page limit.

13 4. On June 4, 2019, attorney Bradley Philip Humphreys responded to my e-mail stating
14 that Defendants consented to California's request for additional pages.


