**JOINT STATUS REPORT PURSUANT TO THE COURT'S OCTOBER 17, 2018 ORDER**

Pursuant to the Court's October 17, 2018 Order, which required that "[o]nce the Ninth Circuit rules in *Karnoski v. Trump*, No. 18-35347 (9th Cir.), and *In re Trump*, No. 18-72159 (9th Cir.), the parties shall, within ten (10) calendar days, meet and confer and file a joint status report proposing any necessary further proceedings in this Court," the parties hereby submit this joint status report. (ECF No. 12.)

On June 14, 2019, the Ninth Circuit issued an opinion addressing both *Karnoski v. Trump* and *In re Trump*. See *Karnoski v. Trump*, No. 18-35347, 2019 WL 2479442 (9th Cir. June 14, 2019), attached as Exhibit A. Having met and conferred, the parties respectfully request that the Court grant them leave to file another joint status report on July 10, 2019, at which time the parties anticipate setting forth their positions with regard to further the proceedings in this Court on Plaintiffs' Motion to Compel Discovery from Dr. Paul R. McHugh, M.D. (ECF No. 1).
