ORDER

Upon consideration of Plaintiffs' Motion to Seal Their Reply and Exhibits A and B in Support of Their Motion to Modify the Court's Scheduling Order for the Limited Purpose of Taking the Deposition of Colonel Danaher Out of Time, this Court GRANTS the motion, FINDING that: (1) Plaintiffs provided sufficient notice of the request; (2) that there are no less drastic alternatives than filing these documents under seal along with publicly filed redacted versions; and (3) that there is good cause to keep these documents under seal because they are subject to the Court's protective order in this case. Therefore, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the unredacted versions of Plaintiffs' Reply in Support of Their Motion to Modify the Court's Scheduling Order for the Limited Purpose of Taking the Deposition of Colonel Danaher Out of Time, and Exhibits A and B to that motion, may remain filed under seal.
