

**ORDER**

On March 18, 2019, Defendants State of Arizona, Gilbert Davidson, and Paul Shannon filed a motion to dismiss based, in part, on lack of subject matter jurisdiction. A plaintiff has 30 days to respond to a motion filed pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(b)(1). LRCiv. 12.1(b), 56.1(d). Plaintiffs now seek an additional two weeks for their response. Defendants do not object. (Doc. 26.)

**IT IS ORDERED** that Plaintiffs’ Motion for Extension of Time (Doc. 25) is **GRANTED**. Plaintiffs shall respond to the motion to dismiss on or before **May 1, 2019**.
