On Wednesday, February 8, 2017, this Court issued an order scheduling a settlement conference in the instant matter between two parties, Plaintiff Anmarie Calgaro and one defendant, J.D.K., with their respective counsel. The order scheduled the settlement conference for March 29, 2017. However, because I have a conflict on that date (another mediation in a matter involving five other parties with a mediator already determined), my office immediately notified your chambers of that conflict with J.D.K.'s counsel, Michael Ponto, of Faegre Baker Daniels LLP.
