**ORDER LIFTING STAY OF  
DISCOVERY**

On July 19, 2019, the Court approved the parties' Joint Stipulation and request to Stay Discovery Pending Decision from the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals in case number 19-35017. (Dkt. 208.) The Ninth Circuit issued its decision on August 23, 2019, which affirmed the Court's entry of a permanent injunction in favor of Plaintiff, but vacated the injunction to the extent it applied to certain defendants in their individual capacities.

Provided the ruling, the parties must meet and confer and make every

effort to stipulate to a discovery plan and schedule for the remaining claims. The Court will hold a telephonic scheduling conference with the parties to discuss the same on September 16, 2019 at 11:00 a.m.
