ORDER

For the reasons stated in the foregoing Memorandum Opinion, it is this 20th day of August, 2019, by the United States District Court for the District of Maryland, hereby:

ORDERED that Defendants' Partial Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings and Motion to Partially Dissolve the Preliminary Injunction (ECF No. 115) is DENIED WITHOUT PREJUDICE IN PART AND DENIED AS MOOT IN PART;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants' Motion to Dissolve the Preliminary Injunction (ECF No. 120) is GRANTED;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Preliminary Injunction (ECF No. 84) is DISSOLVED;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants' Motion to Dismiss Plaintiffs' Second Amended Complaint or, in the Alternative, Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment (ECF No. 158), construed as a motion to dismiss, is GRANTED IN PART AND DENIED IN PART;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants' Motion is GRANTED to the extent it seeks to dismiss Plaintiffs' claims challenging the Ban as moot;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants' Motion is GRANTED to the extent it seeks to dismiss Stone, Cole, Doe 1, Gilbert, Parker, and the ACLU for lack of standing;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Stone's, Cole's, Doe 1's, Gilbert's, Parker's, and the ACLU's claims are DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants' Motion is GRANTED to the extent it seeks to dismiss Plaintiffs' substantive due process claim (Count II) for failure to state a claim;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Count II is DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants' Motion is OTHERWISE DENIED;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiffs' Cross-Motion for Summary Judgment (ECF No. 163) is DENIED WITHOUT PREJUDICE; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants file an Answer within fourteen (14) days of the date of this Order.
