**DEFENDANTS' CONSENT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND TO
PLAINTIFFS' SECOND AMENDED COMPLAINT**

Defendants hereby file this consent motion for an extension of time to respond to Plaintiffs' Second Amended Complaint, ECF No. 148. In support thereof, Defendants state as follows:

1. On August 20, 2019, the Court granted in part and denied in part Defendants' Motion to Dismiss Plaintiffs' Second Amended Complaint or, in the Alternative, Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment, ECF No. 158. ECF No. 264.
2. The Court further ordered that Defendants "file an Answer within fourteen (14) days of the date of this Order." ECF No. 264.
3. Defendants' Answer is currently due September 3, 2019, which falls after the Labor Day Holiday.
4. To permit sufficient time to evaluate the Second Amended Complaint and to prepare an Answer, Defendants request the Court extend the time to respond by 14 days, until September 17, 2019.

5. Defendants have conferred with counsel for Plaintiffs, who consent to the relief requested herein.

6. This is Defendants' first request for extension of time to respond to the Second Amended Complaint, and Defendants do not anticipate the need for any further extension.

WHEREFORE, Defendants respectfully request that the Court extend Defendants' time to respond to Plaintiffs' Second Amended Complaint, ECF No. 148, by 14 days, until September 17, 2019. A proposed order accompanies this motion.
